'ROCK KNOB'

SINGLE VINEYARD

2019 Wrattobully Cabernet Sauvignon

This wine was produced from a small and exceptionally rocky outcrop in the vineyard that sits next to our 21A block. A distinctly different wine to our 21A but equivalent in quality and presence, this wine demanded a single vineyard label of its own. The vines grow roots that penetrate deep into the rock producing small bunches and tiny berries leading to intense fruit flavours and distinctive tannin structures.

Layers of intense dark fruit fill the nose with bay leaf, oregano and bramble adding complexity. The palate is rich with layers of cocoa like tannins, a dark core of brooding red fruits and layers of brown spice notes from a hint of oak. This wine will be making a name for itself for many years to come.

VINTAGE

Despite some nail-biting brushes with frost, 2019 turned out to be an excellent vintage and produced arguably the best wines from the area since 2004. Cool early season conditions led to low yields in Cabernet Sauvignon but all other varieties yielded well. Hot weather in January and February had marginal impact on our vineyard and by the time ripening was well underway in March, conditions had cooled considerably. This led to one of the longest ripening seasons for many years and the last fruit was harvested in May. The long 'hang time' led to fruit of great flavour and balance.

Some outstanding parcels of Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon were picked especially from our 21A Cabernet block. These wines have intense colour and flavour and the long slow ripening has produced very good integration and balance of tannins. At this stage we are expecting 2019 reds to be outstanding.

WINEMAKING


Our best block of Cabernet goes through individual row selection which results in four different hand picks and four different ferments. Once fermented dry, the individual lots were pressed off skins and put to French oak barriques (15% new). After 20 months in oak, the individual barrels were tasted and selected for blending and the wine prepared for bottling.

VINEYARD

Wrattobully is located in the Limestone Coast wine zone. The prominent viticultural feature of the area is the series of ancient beach ridges and dunes which run roughly north-south through the area. These ridges are made up of soft crumbly limestone which weathers to produce the red and brown Terra Rossa clay loam soils so highly prized for grape growing. The ridges and dunes have elevations of up to 30m compared with the neighbouring regions to the south with a Terra Rossa 'high' of less than 5m. The extra elevation on the Wrattobully dunes produce the advantage of cold air drainage which reduces the risk of frost during the growing season.
