2021 Wrattenbully Petit Verdot

While we'll always love making (& drinking!) the well known classics like Shiraz and Chardonnay, we're very proud to be championing the 'Alternate' varieties; lesser known international wines which are perfectly suited to our climate & packed full of flavour.

Don't let the name fool you, there is nothing small or diminutive to this variety. Built from the history of Romans, Petit Verdot is a powerhouse of flavour and colour and our Wrattenbully wine is true to this form. A light herb note dances across the nose, lingering and enticing into a dark palate full of black cherries and blood plums. The fruit is lifted by delicate violets and knitted together with chalky tannins. Best suited to rich meat dishes or aged hard cheese. This wine is drinking well now and will continue to for the next fifteen years.

VINTAGE

Wrattenbully experienced the coolest vintage for many years which led to slow balanced ripening. The quality of the resulting wines is considered by many locals to be the best for 40 years. The cool weather allowed for complete flavour ripening by time sugar ripeness was achieved. This produced great balance across all varieties and exceptional colour and flavour depth in all red varieties. Cabernet Sauvignon was outstanding and our best Merlot parcels have the best colour and flavour we have ever seen from our vineyard.

Our small parcels of alternate varieties are all showing great varietal definition. The most outstanding vintage for many years.

WINEMAKING

In order to showcase the vineyard and variety capabilities, the four reds have been made in the same way. Each variety was picked at ripeness in the cool of the night and cold soaked for three days before being inoculated for ferment. The reds were fermented in static fermenters with twice daily pumpovers for tannin and fruit extraction. Once dry, the resulting wines were pressed off skins and matured in a combination of very old oak and stainless steel to maintain the fruit expression and vineyard hues. After eight months, the reds were blended and prepared for bottling.

VINEYARD

Wrattenbully is located in the Limestone Coast wine zone. The prominent viticultural feature of the area is the series of ancient beach ridges and dunes which run roughly north-south through the area. These ridges are made up of soft crumbly limestone which weathers to produce the red and brown Terra Rossa clay loam soils so highly prized for grape growing. The ridges and dunes have elevations of up to 30m compared with the neighbouring regions to the south with a Terra Rossa 'high' of less than 5m. The extra elevation on the Wrattenbully dunes produce the advantage of cold air drainage which reduces the risk of frost during the growing season.
